- We are starting off the year a bit slow. Hoping to be able to sell a few more agendas at some point. Memberships we are steady on. Usually we get a few more people joining after we hold events like Rising Stars. Also, senior parents will join for their kids to be eligible for scholarships. Last year we did really well on the essay workshop so hopefully this year we will have that same interest.
- Book sales are currently down. We are begging people to please purchase their required reading books at SHS bookstore and not on Amazon, etc. The profits from this support SABC.
- Not a lot of change in budget this year. Some small changes here and there, mostly with decreasing membership due to lower student population and raising essay workshops a bit due to high interest. This year we have to pay more for an accountant to do our taxes. The last guy was doing us a huge favor at \$150. Looking at \$350 at least this year.
- We had to change our Venmo payment policy for the bookstore. Before we just required students to show a screenshot of their parent's Venmo purchase or the purchase on their app. But there were rumors that students were photoshopping the screenshots to pick up a book. Purchases now will be verified within Venmo before handing out the books or agendas. All orders placed by 8pm will be verified for next day pick up.
