- Target enrollment: minimum of 16, suggested maximum of 22 with ultimate max of 24.
- Current registration for the college essay writing workshops, as of 04/17:
  - Session 1, 18
  - Session 2, 22
  - Session 3, 23
  - Session 4, 15
  - Sessions 5 and 6, 3 each
- Last year, at the April meeting, sessions 1-4 were filled at max capacity, with few slots left in sessions 5-6.
- This junior class has 90 fewer students than last year's class.
- Good enrollment by ABC members.
- Accepted a few additional memberships to allow for early registration.
- Word of mouth also helps support program; please share posts.
