Treasurer's Report

Erica Kanj

- A small deposit from Venmo at the beginning of the month for Q1 book sales.
 - Expect many Venmo transactions in the coming days for 2nd quarter books.
- There was a membership deposit from Paypal for just over \$1,000. However, membership is still more than \$1,000 less than where we were a year ago. October 13, 2022 we had \$5,527 in memberships and this year on the same date we had \$4,346.
 - We are not the only parent organization with lower numbers. Athletic boosters have less money also, although their number of total memberships is up.
 - The theory is more people are opting for the cheaper memberships.
 - It should be discussed what "early bird" membership means. We are running it through October 31st this year, which is the same as other years. This membership is only \$10.
 - At max, I propose this run through September 30th, if not August 30th or mid-september. This would truly be an "early bird" membership. This gives time to advertise at curriculum night and the parent principal coffees. After that I really think most people that would join will still join and have no problem paying \$25. Even if we have a few less memberships, we would have more money coming in.
- Submitted all the paperwork to the accountant to do our yearly taxes not due until
 December 15th, gives plenty of time. This is the same accountant we used last year.
 Also used by the music parents and athletic boosters. Located in Independence, the cost is fair but not very responsive.
- Paid our charitable registration fee which is \$50 and is something every non-profit in the state of Ohio must do once per year.
- At the end of September we had \$23,160 in our savings account and \$57,479 in our checking account. After the end of the month is when I do my reconciliation for these totals.
- Upcoming expenses will include payment to Fireside books for our 2nd quarter books, a technology fee and reimbursement for Rising Stars luncheon and National Merit Lunch.
